Beginning **Monday May 19, 2025**, we will be making a minor change to the online system.

When the nurse places an order for a urine (culture or urinalysis) the system will ask for the collection date and time to be entered. We have noticed that we are getting many nurse collected specimens that do not have the collected date and time on the specimen or order. For AHA to complete the ordered testing, we must have this information. Please make sure that the collection date and time on the order matches the collection date and time that is on the specimen container to avoid rejection.

When a urine is ordered, the collection date and time boxes will appear
